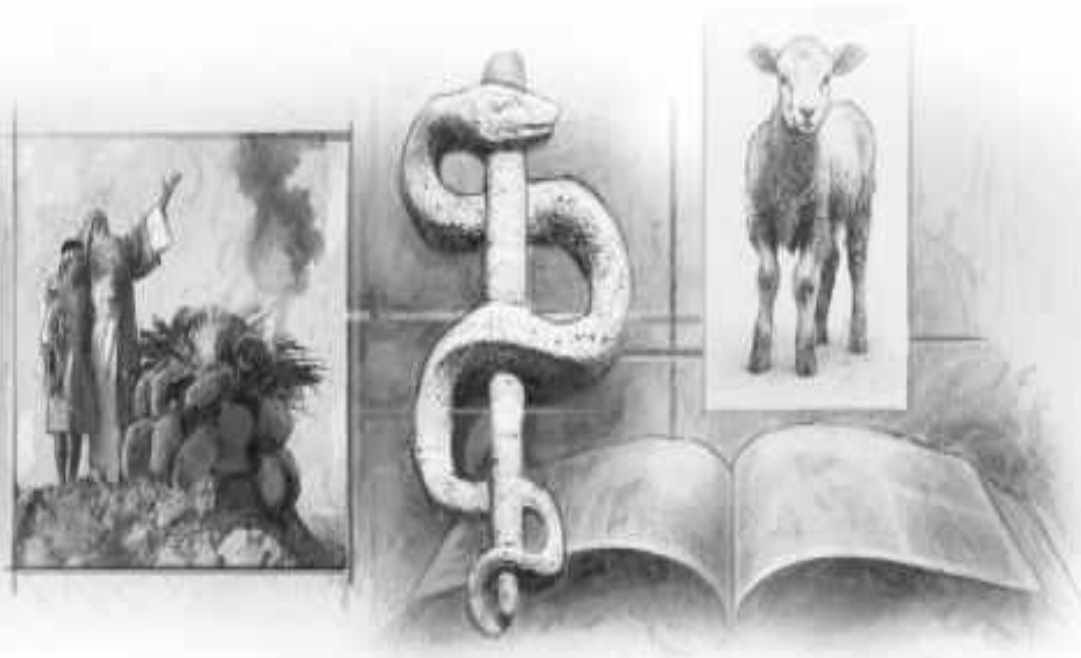

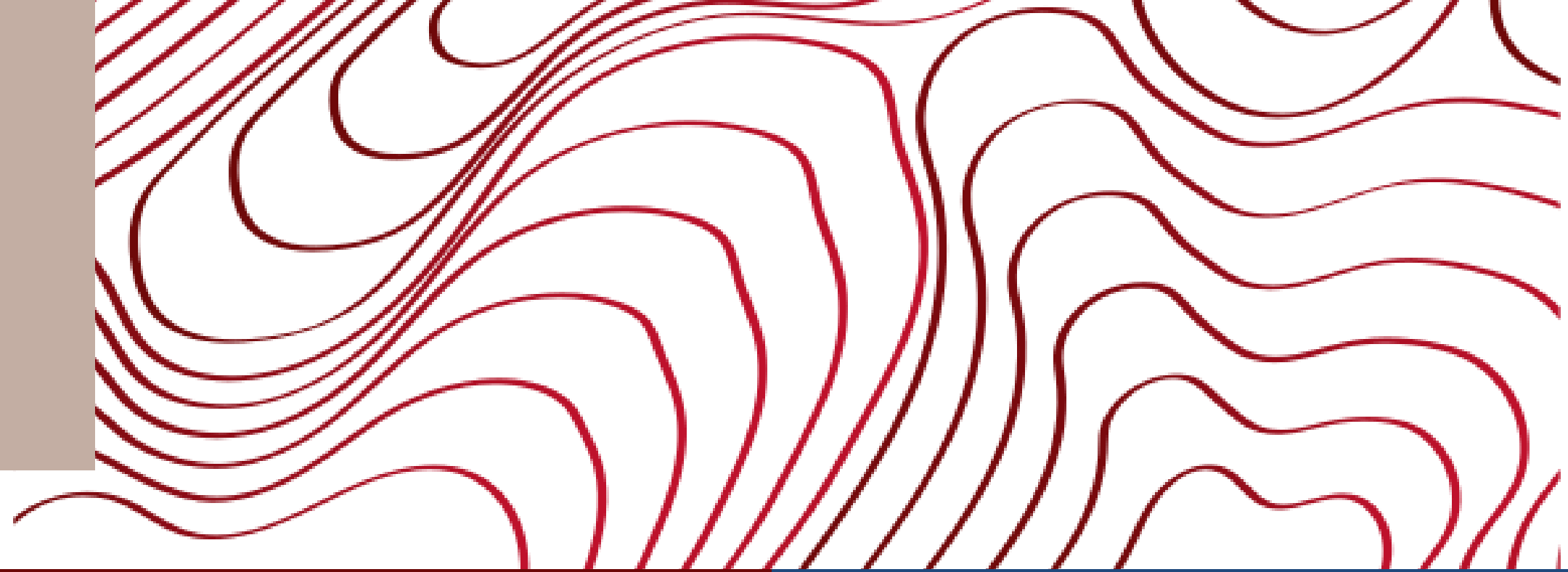
Read for This Week's Study: [Isa. 40:7-8; Gen. 22:1-13; John 3:16; Rev. 5:5-10; 1 Cor. 15:15-19; Rev. 12:1-9](#)

Memory Text: “The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, ‘Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!’ ” ([John 1:29](#), NKJV).

One of the key problems with modern interpretations of Bible prophecy, such as in Revelation, is that they fail to recognize the ancient roots of Revelation. The author assumes a knowledge of the Old Testament and uses concepts that would have been well-known to his audience. While searching the entire Bible for passages that resemble the text you are studying in Revelation is useful, there are also core texts that set the stage for understanding the book better than do other texts. This is particularly true of Genesis, which lays out the path by which our world descended into sinful chaos. Nearly every key concept mentioned in Revelation appears—in some form—in the opening chapters of the Bible.

This week, we are going to study a handful of big concepts at the core of Revelation. There are many, and so we will choose a few to illustrate the all-important point that understanding the ancient foundations behind Revelation enables the student to see countless nuances in the text, each of which can yield important lessons about the nature of humanity, of God, and of the conflict being waged in our universe and, thus, in our lives, as well.

Study this week's lesson to prepare for Sabbath, April 12.

WEEKLY HEALTH READING

Sabbath Health Reading- April, 12

A new Approach of eating



A new way of eating is vital for anyone who is suffering from any of the degenerative diseases, or at risk developing them. The same basic principles apply, whether one is anxiously waiting for coronary bypass surgery, struggling with non-insulin -dependent diabetes, wanting to lose weight and avoid such problems in the future, or simply wanting to feel better and enjoy life more.

Principle 1. What to eat: choose whole plant food that contains 100% of its nutrients. As well as providing optimum nutrition, this gives a sense of satisfaction that is lacking when mainly refined foods are used. For weight-watchers it removes the need to count calories.

Principle 2. When to eat: eat meals at regular intervals, preferably five or six hours apart, with the last meal several hours before bedtime and with no food between meals. Plan to eat a moderately large breakfast and lunch, and a small, light evening meal. This regime makes it much easier to extra calories.

Principle 3. Make major changes in diet and lifestyle gradually, Unless they are medically urgent, Weight loss usually leads to rapid weight regain. A steady small loss, even as little as half a pound a week, is to be preferred. It's easier to maintain and doesn't throw the metabolism into starvation mode.

NB: Remember that whole lifestyle is important including exercise, avoiding poisons, and staying cheerful (*From Your Health in Your Hands. P.54*)
