



Read for This Week's Study: Rev. 6:12-17; Matt. 24:36-44; Gen. 6:1-8; 2 Pet. 2:4-11; Gen. 18:17-32; Dan. 7:9-10


Memory Text: "Now all these things happened to them as examples, and they were written for our admonition, upon whom the ends of the ages have come. Therefore, let him who thinks he stands take heed lest he fall" (1 Corinthians 10:11-12, NKJV).

The Bible is filled with accounts of God's people that point to future events and that hold keys to helping us understand "present truth." In fact, some of those accounts foreshadow last-day events with surprising detail, providing us a broader foundation for understanding the prophecies of Daniel and Revelation clearly.

Without violating an individual's freedom of conscience, God can perfectly steer the events that will happen in the last days, events that He revealed to the prophets. Some of these important stories are obvious, because the New Testament refers to them specifically in describing last-day events: Sodom and Gomorrah, the Flood, etc. Others require careful thought and exploration in order to mine from them the truths that have been given us in the Word of God.

Over the next couple of weeks, we will be searching through a number of key stories in order to see what they might have to say about events such as the Second Coming, the investigative judgment, the final crisis, and more. And, through it all, we find Christ as the center, for He must be the foundation as well as the end goal of all our prophetic endeavors.

Psychology of Pain



Acute and Chronic Pain

Acute pain is caused by an accident, illness or unusual effort, and causes a very strong discomfort which diminishes over time until it disappears. Even without illness or accident, this type of pain can occur when one engages in an activity that uses muscles that have not been used for a long time.

Chronic pain, on the other hand, implies per-manet or semi-permanent presence and is considered such when it lasts for six months or more. It may be continual (such as lower back pain, which is almost always present) or recuring (such as a migraine, that appears intermittently over months and even years).

This pain is difficult to treat, at least in terms of causing it to completely disappear. The elderly most frequently experience chronic lumbar (from various causes), head and arthritic pain.

Chronic pain requires greater attention due to the fact that it is part of life for so many elderly. Depending on which statistics you consult, it is found that some of chronic pain is present among 25% to 80% of causes with more being found in hospitals and residency homes.

Pain serves an important purpose for our survival: through it, our body alerts to change our behaviour, and avoid or correct problems.

Pain occurs in the contexts to health (it causes us to change positions while we sleep and it tells us to stop eating when our stomach is too full), of illness (it sends us signals via a rotten tooth), or of accident (we feel discomfort from a sprained ankle).

For an elderly person, Pain tends to occur more frequently than at other ages. This happens because of the ageing organism and the prevalence of painful illness, such as arthritis or back pain (*Enjoy Life p, 98*).
