SABBATH AFTERNOON


Read for This Week's Study: Ruth 1:1-5; Ruth 2:5-20; Job 1:6-11; Matt. 4:8-9; Esther 3:1-14; Rev. 12:14-17

Memory Text: "So it was, when the king saw Queen Esther standing in the court, that she found favor in his sight, and the king held out to Esther the golden scepter that was in his hand. Then Esther went near and touched the top of the scepter" (Esther 5:2, NKJV).

This week we continue to explore stories that prefigure last-day events. By using real-life events and people, God helps us to see things from His perspective and helps us understand how to interpret the prophecies that come later, which are given to help strengthen our faith.

Our attention turns to two important women whose stories have touched the hearts of countless generations: Ruth and Esther. One is a dispossessed widow who finds hope after meeting the kindly Boaz, her kinsman redeemer. Their marriage has become a favorite love story for Christians because of the way it reflects Christ's love for us. The other is a young girl living in a foreign land who becomes aware of a plot to destroy her people and finds herself thrust onto the main stage in the drama that unfolds to save them. In prophecy, of course, a woman is a powerful symbol for God's church, shedding much light on how God regards His people. Let's look at the biblical accounts of these two women, whose life circumstances have been immortalized in the Word of God, and seek to draw whatever lessons we can from their experiences.

WEEKLY HEALTH READING

Sabbath Health Reading-June, 7



The large majority of elderly benefit from systematic lifestyle. Carrying out daily activities in predictable and methodical way provides calm and security. We do not mean to say that there cannot be exceptions. Without doubt, it is good to break with routine now and again and do something spontaneous: a trip, taking care of grandchildren for a period of time, or simply lazing about for a few days without any responsibility. This improves mental health and provides the chance to practice the art of adaptation. Having said this, the body and mind find peace and security in regular daily activities.

A person finds enjoyment in activities that are well chosen and done in a regular way. This will keep her occupied and will prevent depression. In addition, she will feel a sense of accomplishment upon finishing the activity successfully. But, what habits should an elderly person maintain in order to conserve complete health? What routines are best suited for this? The reality is that most of the book is dedicated to answering this question. In this chapter, we offer some general ideas that will help a person think of a variety of activities.

A human being is a whole person who benefits from development and growth within multiple dimensions of life. For this reason, we recommend that the person reviews his routines to be sure that these areas develop in a harmonious way. The physical facet is of primary importance in order to preserve the corresponding abilities. Any sport, adjusted to your age and physical ability, will be beneficial. Household chores such as cleaning, tidying up, repairing things or a simple 15 or 20 minute walk will improve your physical wellbeing.

The mental facet is absolutely necessary to maintain intellectual agility. This reason, we recommend that you exercise your mind regularly through activities that are designed for this such as working crossword puzzles, sudokus and acrostics or resolving real problems you can also develop your mind through meetings, lectures or debates about current cultural issues.

The social facet is absolutely necessary. We all benefit from mental and emotional health, along with many other satisfactions, through relating to others. You will notice that time goes more quickly when you are with people you appreciate and respect. This means that such interactions are pleasant and beneficial. Find ways to engage with others, visit friends and neighbours, attend functions and meetings (*Enjoy Life p, 76*).
